

Duas from the Qur'an and the Du'a Qunoot

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Du'as from the Qur'an and the Du'a Qunoot

We have included a few important Du'as from the Qur'an. It is highly recommended to learn their recitation and meaning and memorise them. The following are some selected Du'as from the Qur'an with their meanings.

رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي الْآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

'Our Lord! Give us in this world what is good, and, in the Hereafter, what is good, and save us from the torment of the Fire'.

رَبَّنَا لَا تَجْعَلْ قُلُوبَنَا بَعْدَ إِذْ هَدَيْتَنَا وَهَبْ لَنَا مِنْ لَدُنْكَ رَحْمَةً إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ لَوَهَّابٌ

'Our Lord! Do not let our hearts deviate after You have guided us, and grant us Mercy from Your Presence; truly, You are the Most Bountiful'.

رَبَّنَا ظَلَمْنَا أَنْفُسَنَا وَإِنْ لَمْ تَغْفِرْ لَنَا وَتَرْحَمْنَا لَنَكُونَنَّ مِنَ الْخَاسِرِينَ

'Our Lord! We have wronged ourselves, and if You do not forgive us and have mercy upon us, then we shall surely be among the losers.

رَبِّ اغْفِرْ وَارْحَمْ وَأَنْتَ خَيْرُ الْوَالِحِينَ

'O Lord! Forgive and have mercy, for You are the best of those who show mercy'.

رَبَّنَا إِذْنَا سَمِعْنَا مَنَادًا يَقُولُ الَّاٰيٰتِ اَنْ لَّمِنُوْا بِحٰجِبِكُمْ فَاٰمَنَّا رَبَّنَا فَاغْفِرْ لَنَا ذُنُوْبَنَا وَكُوِّعْنَا سِيَّمَاتِنَا وَتَوَقَّفْنَا مَعَ الْاَبْرَارِ

'Our Lord! Verily we have heard a caller calling to Iman (saying): "Believe in Your Lord", and so we have believed. Our Lord! Forgive us, then, our sins, and cover up our evil deeds, and call us up to the company of the righteous'.

رَبَّنَا وَآتِنَا مَا وَعَدْتَنَا عَلَىٰ رُسُلِكَ وَلَا تُخْزِنَا يَوْمَ الْقِيٰمَةِ اِنَّكَ لَآتِمْلُفُ الْمِعَادِ

'Our Lord! Grant us what You have promised to us through Your Messengers, and do not disgrace us on the Day of Resurrection, for You never break Your Promise'.

رَبَّنَا اغْفِرْ لَنَا ذُنُوْبَنَا وَاِسْرَافَنَا فَاْمُرْنَا فَاْمُرِنَا وَوَدِّعْتِ اَقْدَامَنَا وَاَنْصُرْنَا عَلٰى الْقَوْمِ الْكٰفِرِيْنَ

'Our Lord! Forgive us our sins and our transgressions in what we have done, and make our feet firm, and give us victory over the disbelieving people'.

The Du'a Qunoot is read in the last Rak'ah of Saḷaat ul-Witr, either before or after the Rukoo'. There are several versions of it, with the following two being the most common:

لَهُمْ أَنْ نَسْتَعِينَكَ وَنَسْتَغْفِرَكَ وَنُؤْمِنُ بِكَ وَنَتَوَكَّلُ عَلَيْكَ وَنُثْنِي عَلَيْكَ الْخَيْرَ نَشْكُرُكَ وَلَا نَكْفُرُكَ وَنَخْلَعُ لَهُمْ نَعْبَدُكَ وَنُصَلِّيُ وَنَسْجُدُ وَإِلَيْكَ نَسْعِي وَنُفِدُ نَرْجُو رَحْمَتَكَ وَنَشَى عَذَابَكَ إِنْ عَذَابَكَ الْوَنُتْرَكَ الْمَدْبُكُ الْكَافِرِينَ لِمَلْحَقٍ مِنْ يَفْجُوكَ إِلَّا بِكَ

'O Allah! Truly we seek Your help and Your forgiveness, and we believe in You and trust in You. And we praise You in the good way. We are grateful to You, and we do not reject You. And we cast off and leave whoever sins against you. O Allah! You Alone do we worship, and to You we pray and prostrate ourselves. And we rush to You eagerly. We hope for Your mercy, and we fear Your punishment; truly, Your punishment will earnestly overtake the disbelievers'.

اللَّهُمَّ اهْدِنَا فِيمَنْ هَدَيْتَ وَعَافِنَا فِيمَنْ عَافَيْتَ وَتَوَلَّنَا فِيمَنْ تَوَلَّيْتَ وَبِرِّكَ لَنَا فِيمَا أَعْطَيْتَ وَقِنَا شَوْ مَا قَضَيْتَ فَتَقْضِي وَلَا يَقْضِي عَلَيْكَ إِنَّهُ لَا يُلْغِي مِنْ الْإِلَهِيَّةِ وَلَا يَعْرِ مِنْ عَادِيَّتِ تَبَارَكْتَ رَبَّنَا وَتَعَالَيْتَ فَلَمَّا الْمَدْفُكُ عَلَى مَا قَضَيْتَ نَسْتَغْفِرُكَ اللَّهُمَّ وَنَتُوبُ إِلَيْكَ لَا مَنجَا وَلَا مَدْجَا مِنْكَ إِلَّا إِلَيْكَ وَصَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيَّ النَّبِيِّ مُحَمَّدٍ

'O Allah! Guide us with those whom You have guided, and preserve us with those whom You have preserved, and support us with those whom You have supported. Bless us in what You have given and save us from the evil of what You have decreed. For truly, You decree, and no-one can decree against You. Truly the one whom You have befriended can never be abased, and the one against whom You have declared enmity can never be exalted. Blessed are You, O our Lord, and Exalted; and to You is the praise for what You have decreed. We seek Your forgiveness, O Allah, and we repent to You. There is no shelter nor safety except by approaching You. And may Allah bless the Prophet Muḥammad'.
