Australian International Islamic College was established in 2002 at Woolloongabba in Brisbane with 20 students and then expanded to Durack in 2005 due to the response and rapid growth of enrollment.

In 2010, it also extended to Gold Coast and in 2020; we have established our fourth campus at Logan.

AIIC offers a comprehensive Australian curriculum and syllabus from Kindergarten to year 12 across all four campuses.

AllC is registered and funded by both State and Federal Governments.

Today is a very important day for us, a fifth campus here in Darwin will be commencing in 2022 academic year Insha Allah.

AIIC aims to provide 2000 strong Territorian Muslims who would like to educate their children in a caring, safe and Islamic environment where they can connect with their cultural and religious roots so that they can thrive and contribute to the territory and Australia positively by fulfilling the AIIC's motto, 'Excellence in education, character and service'. We do not consider ourselves as a traditional school, rather we consider ourselves as a strong community partner that forge a strong relationship with neighbours, other organisations, councils and government agencies.

We have also developed sister school participation with several schools in Indonesia, Malaysia and United Arab Emirates in order to attract International students to study at our school and enrol in Australian universities after their graduation.

AIIC Darwin proposes to establish and to focus on primary school, which will eventually cater up to Year 12. Our vision is to become an institution of choice to educate students to become model citizens with a greater level of academic excellence and Islamic values.

At Australian International Islamic College all, our teachers are fully qualified and registered with the education department. We will shortly be advertising and appointing suitable staff for our Darwin Campus Insha Allah.

Honourable minsters, members of parliament and community leaders, dear parents and future students, I would like to welcome you all to this important event of the establishment of the first Islamic school in Darwin.
